



1. **Call to Order -** Berryville-Clarke County Government Center

Front parking lot at 2:00pm
2. **First Discussion –** The meeting resumed at the corner of Mosby Blvd. and McClellan Street. The Council discussed options for pavement marking, parking restrictions, and snow emergency route designation. By consensus, the Council referred the matter to the Streets and Utilities Committee for a final recommendation to be provided to the Town Council at the November meeting.
3. **Second Discussion –** The meeting resumed on North Buckmarsh St. near the intersection of Treadwell St. The Council discussed parking and snow emergency route designation.
4. **Third Discussion --** The meeting resumed in the Crow Street parking lot. The Council discussed downtown parking meters. By consensus, the Council directed staff to finalize a recommendation for the October Town Council Meeting.
5. **Other –** Recorder Arnold stated that Berryville Main Street was looking into the idea of lowering the downtown banners to reduce the costs associated with removing and installing the banners. By consensus it was recommended that Berryville Main Street develop a proposal and submit it for review.
